





Those readers who are teachers of mediumship or administrators of mediumship programs know that teaching mediumship is not easy. In this book, Kay shares the tricks of the trade, breaking down the teaching curriculum and exercises into incremental phases that even the newest learner can understand and follow.

What sets Kay's book apart from other books on mediumship? Kay knows how to teach and how to relate complex information in simple terms. Because ninety-five percent of the work you will do as a developing medium is healing your own soul—from the inside out—so you can deepen your connection with the God Source. Self-development practices are incorporated into each chapter, and you can use your own journal or purchase the journal designed to go along with this book.


Why Kay Wrote this Book-




